Meet Ethan. He's a tall, lanky, fun-loving, quick-witted life of the party. He's 27, looks 21, smiles a lot, has a contagious laugh and can talk the ear off a perfect-stranger. Ethan's a son, brother, uncle and daddy. Ethan's a meth addict.

He's in jail again so I see him there. We meet in a small, cement-block room with a table and a couple chairs. When I told him we were working on a newsletter he asked to contribute. So I asked what he had to say about ATLAS. Here's what he shared:

"I never had anything in my life before like ATLAS. It's a place where you're welcomed no matter what. I learned a lot about myself there and could talk about my addiction with people I trust. It helps to let go of the crap I try to hide from everybody. You can talk about anything and they won't judge you. Feeling worthless kept me on a destructive path but at ATLAS I learned I'm not worthless and I'm starting to see things in a different light. ATLAS taught me how to start respecting myself and others. They tell me there's always hope even when you're down. They welcome you back with open arms if you fall backward—even if you go to prison they still write and will be in your corner. They see the good in you even when you

Thanks for sharing, Ethan. Your words will give hope to others out there walking a similar path. And, Mr. Ethan, remember this: Jesus CAN see the good in you—even when you can't. . . and so can I.

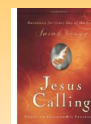

The car ministry of ATLAS (CMA) gratefully takes donations from people who are willing to give their used vehicles to people in need.

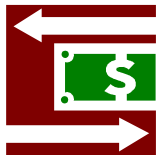


CMA has volunteer mechanics who work on those donated vehicles in order to get them into the best possible operating condition before giving them away.

An interview committee meets with each potential recipient and their advocate (from any ATLAS organization) to talk about life changes, positive progress and accountability. The committee then decides who will receive a vehicle.

Since its inception in 2011, CMA has been able to provide over 80 people in need with used vehicles from private donations. If you are interested in donating a vehicle, please consider donating it to the **Car Ministry of ATLAS** for an income tax deduction. You're also welcome to give financially to this ministry. CMA uses the finances to buy parts for vehicles so that they can be repaired and ready for a new owner. 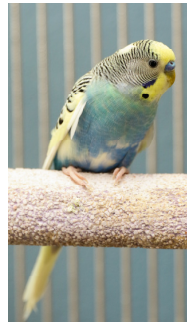
